20	The Motion of the Court-Appointed Permanent Receiver, Stephen J. Donell	
21	(the "Receiver"), for Order Approving Final Distribution Amount and Authorizing	
22	Final Distribution (the "Motion") came for hearing before this Court on May 13,	
23	2019. Having considered the Motion and all supporting and attendant materials, and	
24	good cause appearing therefor, this Court ORDERS as follows:	
25	1. The Receiver's Motion is granted, in its entirety;	
26	2. The Receiver's proposed final distribution calculation, and proposed	
27	final amount for distribution on allowed claims against the entities in receivership in	
28	this matter, as detailed in the Motion, are approved;	

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3. In connection with his contemplated final distribution on allowed
 claims, the Receiver is authorized to retain and distribute all funds turned over to
 him, or frozen in, bank accounts held in the name of, or for the benefit of Yanrob's
 Medical, Inc.;

5 4. The Receiver is authorized to set aside, from cash on-hand, a total of
6 \$246,432.70 to cover accrued hold-backs of already approved administrative and
7 professional fees;

8 5. The Receiver is authorized to set aside, from cash on-hand, a total of
9 \$42,626.62 to cover accrued administrative and professional fees and expenses, for
10 the period from August 1, 2018 through January 31, 2019;

6. The Receiver is authorized to set aside a reserve of \$40,000.00 to cover
estimated administrative and professional fees and expenses from February 1, 2019
through the termination of the instant receivership; and

14 7. The Receiver is authorized to make a final distribution on claims
15 already allowed by the Court in the aggregate amount of \$2,918,952.04, plus
16 accrued interest thereon, if any, on a *pro rata* basis.
