The Receiver's proposed final distribution calculation, and proposed 26 27 final amount for distribution on allowed claims against the entities in receivership in this matter, as detailed in the Motion, are approved; 28

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1	3. In connection with his contemplated final distribution on allowed
2	claims, the Receiver is authorized to retain and distribute all funds turned over to
3	him, or frozen in, bank accounts held in the name of, or for the benefit of Yanrob's
4	Medical, Inc.;
5	4. The Receiver is authorized to set aside, from cash on-hand, a total of
6	\$246,432.70 to cover accrued hold-backs of already approved administrative and
7	professional fees;
8	5. The Receiver is authorized to set aside, from cash on-hand, a total of
9	\$42,626.62 to cover accrued administrative and professional fees and expenses, for
10	the period from August 1, 2018 through January 31, 2019;
11	6. The Receiver is authorized to set aside a reserve of \$40,000.00 to cover
12	estimated administrative and professional fees and expenses from February 1, 2019
13	through the termination of the instant receivership; and
14	7. The Receiver is authorized to make a final distribution on claims
15	already allowed by the Court in the aggregate amount of \$2,918,952.04, plus
16	accrued interest thereon, if any, on a pro rata basis.
