Before the Court is the parties’ Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings for Sixty Days Pending Filing of Stipulated Orders for Permanent Injunction and Monetary Judgment (Doc. 51). The Joint Motion is between Plaintiff and Defendants Michael Ford Hilliard, Amazing App, LLC, Hite Media Group, LLC, Michael De Rosa, Tiffany Hoffman, and 2 Unique, LLC (the “Appearing Defendants”). The Clerk of Court entered default judgment against the remaining defendants on August 29, 2018. (Doc. 35.) Plaintiff and Appearing Defendants have notified the Court that they have negotiated orders for permanent injunction and monetary judgment as against the Appearing Defendants and that Plaintiff will submit the orders to the FTC for formal agency approval. (Doc. 51 at 2.)

Accordingly, having reviewed the parties’ motion,


IT IS ORDERED:
