Based upon the agreements of the parties, and for good cause shown, the Court orders as follows:

- 1. Stephen J. Donell is appointed as receiver ("Receiver") of Tarzana Plaza Condominiums Association ("Plaintiff"), effective immediately.
- There will be a separate order designating the powers of the Receiver and setting the date and time confirmation of the Receiver, which Order is incorporated by this reference.
- The Receiver shall remain in place for nine months, subject to further order of the Court.
- 4. The existing members of Plaintiff's Board of Directors ("Board") have agreed to resign, and the Board is disbanded, effective immediately. Each member of the Board will tender his or her resignation to the Receiver within five (5) days of the entry of this Order.
- The recall election of the Board, currently scheduled for June 26,
 2018, is vacated as moot.
- 6. Two former members of the Board will act as liaisons and "point people" for problems in Plaintiff's building and to provide background information and documents to the Receiver. One liaison will be Judy Weiss, the other will be Silvana Salaali. Both of the liaisons will be provided with keys to the party room and the boiler and access to the video cameras on the property for the use of the building to help the police department and the fire department do their job.
- 7. The Receiver will ensure that there will be an annual election of the Board held on February 1, 2019.

 Board held on February 1, 2019.
- 8. The actions of the Receiver will comply with the Davis-Stirling Act all other provisions of the California Civil Code, and Plaintiff's CC&R's and bylaws.
- 9. Eugene Saal, one of the defendants in this action, shall never attend any meeting of the members of Plaintiff's homeowners association ("HOA")

and shall never seek election as a member of the Board.

- Except as set forth in this Order, there is a stay of all actions pending in this case. Once the Court orders that the Receiver is discharged, this case will be dismissed with prejudice, with each side to bear his, her, or its costs and fees, and the new Board will immediately resume control of Plaintiff's operations.
- 11. Nothing in this Order precludes any person from filing a paper or bringing a motion, whether by regular notice or by ex parte application, to address any issues regarding the receivership, the annual election, or any actions which the Receiver may bring before this Court.
- Stephen Levine and the firm of Wolf, Rifkin, Shapiro, Schulman & 12. Rabkin, LLP ("Firm") shall not be employed by the Receiver or by Plaintiff. The Firm shall not be entitled to receive any fees from the HOA/Receivership Estate for any work performed after May 17, 2018, without prior court approval.
